## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Denise McKinnon, an employee of the Massachusetts Hospital School.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule, or regulation to the
- 2 contrary, the Executive Office of Health and Human Services shall establish a sick leave bank
- 3 for, Denise McKinnon, an employee of the Massachusetts Hospital School. Any employee of the
- 4 office may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank
- 5 for use by Denise McKinnon. Whenever Denise McKinnon terminates employment with the
- 6 office or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall
- 7 be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for
- 8 absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave
- 9 bank as determined by the Executive Office of Health and Human Services.
