An Act relative to Northeast Regional Infrastructure Bank.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is hereby
2	directed to explore establishing a Northeast Regional Infrastructure Bank (NRIB) with other
3	northeastern states' transportation departments including, but not limited to, Maine, New
4	Hampshire, Vermont, Connecticut, and Rhode Island, for the purpose of creating a regional
5	vision, prioritization, and investment in transportation projects.
