Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 64H of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 striking the words "6.25 per cent" and inserting in place thereof the words "5.8 per cent".
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 2 of said chapter 64H, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
- 4 striking the words "6.25 per cent" and inserting in place thereof the words "5.4 per cent".
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 2 of said chapter 64H, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
- 6 striking the words "6.25 per cent" and inserting in place thereof the words "5 per cent".
- 7 SECTION 4. Section 2 of Chapter 64I of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
- 8 the words "6.25 per cent" and inserting in place thereof the words "5.8 per cent".

- 9 SECTION 5. Section 2 of said chapter 64I, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
- striking the words "6.25 per cent" and inserting in place thereof the words "5.4 per cent".
- SECTION 6. Section 2 of said chapter 64I, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking the words "6.25 per cent" and inserting in place thereof the words "5 per cent".
- SECTION 7. Sections 1 and 4 shall take effect on August 1, 2021.
- SECTION 8. Sections 2 and 5 shall take effect on August 1, 2022.
- SECTION 9. Sections 3 and 6 shall take effect on August 1, 2023.
