## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to continuing education requirements for inspectors of boilers and amusement devices.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 62 of chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after the third paragraph the following paragraph:-
- 3 The department shall promulgate regulations which shall require the renewal of such
- 4 certifications every two years. Commencing with the renewal of certification on July 1, 2015, all
- 5 individuals certified by the commonwealth as an inspector of boilers or amusement devices shall
- 6 demonstrate the satisfactory completion of continuing education courses as determined by the
- 7 department.
