By Mr. Joyce, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 2001) of Brian A. Joyce and Walter F. Timilty (by vote of the town) for legislation relative to a quorum of a public body in the town of Milton. Municipalities and Regional Government. [Local Approval Received.]

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act regarding a quorum of a public body in the town of Milton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the
- 2 contract, in circumstances in the town of Milton where a quorum of a public body is a simple
- 3 majority of the members of that public body, the quorum shall be a simple majority of the
- 4 members appointed to that public body, rather than a simple majority of the number of members
- 5 of that public body as authorized.
- 6 SECTION 2. In this context a "public body" is a multiple member board, commission,
- 7 committee, or subcommittee within the executive or legislative branch of the town of Milton,
- 8 however created, appointed, or otherwise constituted, established to serve a public purpose, but
- 9 shall not include a multiple member board, commission, committee or subcommittee whose
- 10 members are elected by registered voters of the town.
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
