**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Dean Canada, an employee of the Department of Correction.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Whereas, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to
2 establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Department of Correction,
3 therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation
4 of the public convenience.

5 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Department
6 of Correction shall establish a sick leave bank for Dean Canada, an employee of the department.
7 Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation
8 days to the sick leave bank for use by Dean Canada. If Dean Canada terminates employment
9 with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick
10 leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not
11 be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of
12 the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
