Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 2 of the general laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended, by inserting after section 31, the following new section:-
- 3 Section 31A . The song, “Me and Paul Revere,” by Steve Martin and the Steep Canyon
- 4 Rangers, shall be the revolutionary song of the Commonwealth.
