An Act to promote and advance motorcycle safety.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 34 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “safety”, in line 7, the following  
3 words:-  
  
4           ; provided, however, that the registrar shall provide rebates of not less than \$100 to  
5 persons under the age of 21 who successfully complete a motorcycle basic rider course approved  
6 by the registrar pursuant to Section 8 and that the total of such rebates shall not exceed 20 per  
7 cent of the funds so deposited.
