Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting in section 54B the following new paragraph at the end thereof:-
- 3 The Department of Education and Department of Public Health shall jointly promulgate
- 4 regulations, within 180 days of the passage of this act, to allow for training of school employees
- 5 in the emergency administration of glucagon for students with diabetes. Said regulations shall
- 6 allow for administration of glucagon by a trained member(s) of the school staff when a nurse is
- 7 not present and the student exhibits symptoms of severe hypoglycemia. And provided further,
- 8 that the parent or legal guardian of the student has submitted in writing permission for such
- 9 emergency treatment to be rendered; and provided further that a member of the school staff who,
- in good faith, administers glucagon to a student who exhibits symptoms of severe hypoglycemia

- shall not be held liable in a suit for damages as a result of his acts or omissions, nor shall such
- person be subject to any disciplinary action for such emergency aid.
