An Act designating a certain intersection in the town of Plainville as the Special Police Officer Michael O. Maher Memorial Intersection.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The intersection of the Plainridge Park Casino access road and state  
2 highway Route 1 in the town of Plainville shall be designated and known as the Special Police  
3 Officer Michael O. Maher Memorial Intersection, in memory of Plainville Special Police Officer  
4 Michael O. Maher, who was killed in the line of duty. The Massachusetts Department of  
5 Transportation shall erect and maintain a suitable marker bearing the designation in compliance  
6 with the standards of the department.
