#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to pipeline siting.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 94A of chapter 164 of the General Laws is amended by inserting, at the end
- 2 thereof, the following paragraph:-
- The department shall not approve any pipeline capacity contract or gas storage contract
- 4 where new capacity is proposed to be created through the installation of gas infrastructure in land
- 5 that, at the time the contract is submitted to the department for approval, is protected under
- 6 Article 97 of the Articles of Amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth. Subsequent
- 7 siting approvals of gas infrastructure in such constitutionally protected land shall void
- 8 departmental approval of related pipeline capacity or gas storage contracts.
