An Act relative to special education transportation costs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: The fourth sentence of subsection (a) of section 5A of chapter
2 71B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out the word “not” and said section is further amended by striking, in lines 26 and 27,
4 the following words: - “transportation costs”.
