**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act relative to the maximum storage charges on motor vehicles involuntarily towed.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 6B of chapter 159B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in the second paragraph, the number “35” and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the number “48”.
