By Mr. Timilty, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 219) of Walter F. Timilty, William J. Driscoll, Jr. and Brandy Fluker Oakley (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the town of Milton to issue a license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises. **In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act authorizing the town of Milton to issue a license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding sections 11, 15 and 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws
2 or any other general or special law to the contrary, the town of Milton may issue to 1 Eliot Street
3 LLC or its successor in interest a license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the
4 premises of a restaurant located at 1 Eliot street in said town. The license shall not be
5 transferable to another licensed premises. Said license shall be subject to all of said chapter 148,
6 except said sections 11, 15 and 17.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
