Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Clause Forty-first A of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 2 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 1199, the words "chapter sixty"
- and inserting in place thereof the following:-
- chapter 60, or such lesser rate as may be determined by the legislative body of the city or
- 5 town, subject to its charter.
