The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act establishing a charter school working group.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. There is hereby established a charter school working group to study the
- 2 equity in funding and innovations promoted by charter schools authorized under the provisions
- 3 of chapter 71, section 89. The working group shall report its findings and conclusions to the
- 4 general court and make recommendations regarding any necessary legislative and regulatory
- 5 changes which are suggested by those findings and conclusions. The first meeting of the
- 6 working group shall take place within 30 days after the effective date of this act.
- 7 SECTION 2. The working group shall consist of the speaker of the House of
- 8 Representatives, or his designee, who shall serve as co-chair, the president of the senate, or her
- 9 designee, who shall serve as co-chair; the minority leaders of the house and senate, or their
- 10 designees; the house and senate chairs of the joint committee on education; the chairs of the
- 11 house and senate committee on ways and mean; the secretary of administration and finance, or

- 12 her designee; the secretary of education or his designee; the Commissioner of Elementary and
- 13 Secondary Education, or his designee; and 2 appointees of the Governor.
- SECTION 3. The working group shall solicit advice from such persons and entities as it deems necessary.
- SECTION 4. The working group shall file a report containing its recommendations,
- 17 including legislation and regulations necessary to carry outs its recommendations, with the joint
- 18 committee on education and the clerks of the house and senate not later than 9 months following
- 19 the first meeting of the working group.
