In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Linda Thernize-Williams, an employee of the Department of Transitional Assistance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Department of 2 Transitional Assistance shall establish a sick leave bank for Linda Thernize-Williams, an 3 employee of the Department of Transitional Assistance. Any employee of the department may 4 voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by 5 Linda Thernize-Williams. If Linda Thernize-Williams terminates employment with the 6 department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank 7 shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for 8 absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave 9 bank as determined by the department.
