In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to variable pricing e-tolling.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 13 of chapter 6C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,

2 is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-

3	(d) The department shall design and implement a state wide program for charging toll
4	rates that are different depending on time of day, with the goal of relieving congestion for
5	motorists. The program shall be based on variable pricing, including a discount structure
6	including off-peak discounts of at least 25 per cent and peak premiums of at most 25 per cent.
7	Only vehicles with transponders issued by the commonwealth shall be eligible for discounts.
8	Provided further that the program shall commence no later than December 31, 2022. The
9	department shall transmit an annual report to the clerks of the house and senate detailing the

- 10 scope of the program, implementation challenges, lessons learned, and proposed next steps to use
- 11 tolling policies as a means to alleviate congestion on roadways.
