An Act relative to the removal or transportation of trash.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1   Section 31A of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 6, the words “business, commercial  
3 or”.

4           SECTION 2   Section 31A of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012  
5 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 6 after the words “industrial use” the  
6 following new words: “Cities and towns shall not allow for the collection garbage, offal or other  
7 offensive substances for in areas zoned for business or commercial use between the hours of ten-  
8 o’clock in the evening and five-thirty o’clock in the morning in areas that abut residential  
9 neighborhoods.”
