An Act establishing Arbor and Bird days.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 15 of Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
- 2 the words "and Bird" in both lines 1 and 6, and is further amended by striking the words
- 3 "particularly those attractive to birds," in lines 2-3.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 15 is further amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- 5 The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart May Fourth as Bird Day,
- 6 recommending its observance by the public in the planting of trees, shrubs, and vines,
- 7 particularly those attractive to birds, and through the promotion of bird education and bird
- 8 watching activities to further enhance our understanding of the critical role that birds serve in our
- 9 ecosystem.
