Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 2E of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (d) the following subsection:-
- 3 (e) The registrar shall furnish, upon application, to the owners of private passenger motor
- 4 vehicles distinctive registration plates which shall display on the face a design indicating support
- 5 for the arts. Such a design shall be selected through a contest to be judged by the Massachusetts
- 6 Cultural Council or their designees. There shall be a fee of not less than \$50 dollars for such
- 7 plates in addition to the established registration fee for private passenger motor vehicles, which
- 8 shall be payable at the time of registration of the vehicle and at each renewal thereof. The portion
- 9 of the total fee remaining after the deduction of costs directly attributable to the issuance of such

- plates shall be transferred within ninety days of receipt thereof to the Massachusetts Cultural
- 11 Council.
