Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The bridge on Gray Street over the Boston and Maine Railroad tracks in the town of
- 2 Billerica shall be designated the Helen Knight bridge in honor of Helen Knight, an
- 3 environmental and community activist on behalf of the town, whose work led to the remediation
- 4 of the Iron Horse Park, a declared Superfund Site. A suitable marker bearing said designation
- 5 shall be erected thereat by the department of public works in compliance with the standards of
- 6 said department.
