An Act naming a certain bridge in the town of Methuen.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any rule or regulation of the department of highways to the contrary, the  
2 bridge No. M-17-001 on Route 110 over Bartlett Brook in the Town of Methuen shall be  
3 designated and known as the PFC Eric D. Currier Bridge in honor of PFC Eric D. Currier  
4 U.S.M.C. who was killed in action in Afghanistan. The department of highways shall erect  
5 suitable markers bearing this designation in compliance with the standards of the department and  
6 any existing historic preservation guidelines or statutes.
