Schmid, III (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the town of Freetown to pay a certain unpaid bill. Municipalities and Regional Government. [Local Approval Received.]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen

An Act authorizing the town of Freetown to pay a certain unpaid bill.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Treasurer of the town of Freetown may pay, from sums appropriated,
- 2 an unpaid bill incurred by the town in the amount of \$59,000, which is legally unenforceable
- 3 against the town, to Architectural Consulting Group, LLC, for consulting services provided to
- 4 the town in connection with a planning study with respect to the rehabilitation, reuse,
- 5 consolidation, and reconstruction of certain town-owned buildings, notwithstanding the failure of
- 6 the town to comply with the laws relative to procurement and competitive bidding in the
- 7 awarding of the contract.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
