In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act concerning the conveyance of certain parcels of land in the city of Revere.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to authorize a transfer of certain of land of the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority to the city of Revere, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 877 of the acts of 1977 is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

2 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding section 2, the Authority may convey all or a portion of the

3 parcels in fee to the city of Revere for redevelopment consistent with this act.
