An Act designating a certain bridge in the town of Dedham as the Honorable Kelly A. Timilty  
Memorial Bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1            Bridge D-05-011 on Sawmill Lane, spanning Mother Brook in the Town of Dedham,  
2 shall be designated and known as the “Honorable Kelly A. Timilty Memorial Bridge” in  
3 recognition of Kelly A. Timilty. Kelly was a beloved public servant who served nine consecutive  
4 terms before five governors on the Governor’s Council. Kelly was the youngest child of Joseph  
5 F. Timilty, former state senator, and the sister of the Honorable James E. Timilty. She passed  
6 away before her time on January 31, 2012. The Massachusetts Department of Transportation  
7 shall erect and maintain a suitable marker bearing the designation in compliance with the  
8 standards of the department.
