In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to charter revocation .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 89 of Chapter 71 of the general laws is hereby amended in section (ee) by
2 striking the first sentence and replacing it with the following: - “The board may revoke a
3 school’s charter if the school has not fulfilled any conditions imposed by the board in connection
4 with the grant of the charter, the school has violated any provision of its charter, or the board has
5 substantially violated any provision of this section or its implementing regulations in granting the
6 charter”.
