An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Jessica R. Brand, an employee of the Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the division of  
2 capital asset management and maintenance shall establish a sick leave bank for Jessica R. Brand,  
3 an employee of the division. Any employee of the division may voluntarily contribute 1 or more  
4 sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Jessica R. Brand. Whenever  
5 Jessica R. Brand terminates employment with the division or requests to dissolve the sick leave  
6 bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave  
7 bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability  
8 that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the division.
