An Act providing for a waiver of a certain payment of dues for veterans and active and retired Armed Forces members.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 211 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

2 Section 29. Notwithstanding any law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the board of bar  
3 overseers shall not assess an annual registration fee to a veteran or a current or retired member of  
4 the armed forces engaged in the practice of law in the Commonwealth.
