# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts 

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court

An Act An act relative to gaming.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1- There is hereby established and set up on the books of the Commonwealth a
2 fund to be known as the "Priority Expense Fund", in which shall be deposited all of the proceeds
3 from the internet gaming, so-called, as authorized by Section 2 of this act, together with any
4 sums appropriated from time to time by the General Court, and any funds obtained by grants,
5 gifts or other means.

Section 2- Chapter 23K of the general laws is hereby amended by adding the following
7 new section

9 pursuant to Chapter 23K of the general laws may also be licensed, subject to the other provisions
10 of said chapter and such other rules and regulations as the commission may establish, to conduct

11 gaming operations via the internet, provided that such operations do not include or reflect

14 this section. An applicant for an Internet Gaming License shall conform to all other relevant 15 provisions of this chapter.
