### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to DESE contracts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1 of Chapter 15 of the general laws is hereby amended by inserting at the end
- 2 thereof, the following new subsection:- (1u)- Notwithstanding any general or special law to the
- 3 contrary, neither the Commissioner of Education nor any designee shall enter into any contract
- 4 for the development or submission of any application for funding from the federal government of
- 5 the United States unless the contract is approved by a vote of the Board of Elementary and
- 6 Secondary Education following written notice to the board of the contents of the contract and a
- 7 fair opportunity for deliberation on the approval or disapproval of such contract.
