An Act clarifying language for the selection of school committee chairs and vice-chairs in the town of Greenfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 4-2 of the charter of the town of Greenfield, which is on file in the

2 office of the archivist of the commonwealth, as provided in section 12 of chapter 43B of the

3 General Laws, is hereby amended by striking out subsection (a) and inserting in place thereof the

4 following:-

5 (a) Election and Term - As soon as practicable after the School Committee members-elect have

6 been qualified following each Town election, as provided in section 8-8, the School Committee

7 shall organize by electing one (1) of its members to serve as School Committee chair and one (1)

8 of its members to serve as School Committee vice chair until the next Town election.
