An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Donald Mahoney, an employee of the Department of Correction.

Whereas, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the department of corrections, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the
2 department of corrections shall establish a sick leave bank for Donald Mahoney, an employee of
3 the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,
4 personal, or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Donald Mahoney. Whenever Donald
5 Mahoney terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank,
6 any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the department of transitional
7 assistance paid leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the

- 8 illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by
- 9 the department of correction.
