In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act relative to bylaws in the town of Greenfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (m) of section 1-7 of the charter of the city known as the town of
2 Greenfield, which is on file in the office of the archivist of the commonwealth as provided in
3 section 12 of chapter 43B of the General Laws, is hereby amended by striking out the word
4 “bylaw” and inserting in place thereof the following word:- ordinance.

5 SECTION 2. Subsection (b) of section 2-2 of said charter is hereby amended by striking
6 out the word “bylaw” and inserting in place thereof the following word:- ordinance.

7 SECTION 3. Subsection (b) of section 2-4 of said charter is hereby amended by striking
8 out the word “bylaw” and inserting in place thereof the following word:- ordinance.

9 SECTION 4. Subsection (b) of section 2-6 of said charter is hereby amended by striking
10 out the word “bylaw” and inserting in place thereof the following word:- ordinance.

11 SECTION 5. Subsection (a) of section 2-8 of said charter is hereby amended by striking
12 out the word “bylaw”, each time it appears, and inserting in place thereof the following:-
