### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Karen Tavernier, an employee of the Department of Transportation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department
- 2 of transportation shall establish a sick leave bank for Karen Tavernier, an employee of the
- 3 department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal
- 4 or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Karen Tavernier. If Karen Tavernier terminates
- 5 employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time
- 6 in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank
- 7 days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the
- 8 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
