An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Lisa Eppy, an employee of the Department of Children and Families.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department of children  
2           and families shall establish a sick leave bank for Lisa Eppy, an employee of the department. Any  
3           employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days  
4           to the sick leave bank for use by Lisa Eppy. Whenever Lisa Eppy terminates employment with  
5           the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave  
6           bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be  
7           used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the  
8           sick leave bank as determined by the department.
