An Act relative to regional school transportation funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 16C of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof, the following:-

3 “Should the payment from the commonwealth be insufficient to reimburse the full
4 amount expended for transportation, the local appropriating authority of any participating city or
5 town in a regional school district, may, by a vote of each, assess reasonable fees to a transported
6 student necessary to meet the obligations set forth in this section. Any fee assessed pursuant to
7 this section shall not be greater than the amount necessary to cover the costs incurred by the
8 district.”
