An Act relative to long term care insurance claims..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 118E of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out Section 33, as so
- 2 appearing, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-
- 3 Section 33. No claim for costs of a nursing facility and other long-term care services may
- 4 be made by the division under section 31 or 32 if the individual receiving medical assistance was
- 5 permanently institutionalized, had notified the division that he had no intention to return home
- 6 and, on the date of admission to the nursing facility or other medical institution, had long-term
- 7 care insurance that, when purchased, met the requirements of 211 C.M.R. 65.00.
