Senate, December 20, 2018 – Text of the Senate amendment (Senator Chang-Diaz) to the House Bill relative to the Massachusetts Port Authority community advisory committee (House, No. 4101).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

Section 36 of chapter 465 of the acts of 1956 is hereby amended by striking out

2 subsection (a), as most recently amended by section 50 of chapter 10 of the acts of 2015, and 3 inserting in place thereof the following subsection:-4 (a) There shall be an advisory board to the authority which shall be named the 5 Massachusetts Port Authority Community Advisory Committee, which shall consist of: (i) 1 6 voting member from each of the following cities and towns, to be appointed by the chief 7 executive officer of each city or town: Arlington, Bedford, Belmont, Beverly, Braintree, 8 Brookline, Cambridge, Canton, Chelsea, Cohasset, Concord, Everett, Hingham, Hull, Lexington, 9 Lincoln, Lynn, Malden, Marblehead, Melrose, Medford, Milton, Nahant, Quincy, Randolph, 10 Revere, Salem, Scituate, Somerville, Swampscott, Watertown, Weymouth, Worcester and 11 Winthrop; and (ii) 7 voting members from the city of Boston, to be appointed by the mayor, 1 of 12 whom shall be from the East Boston section of the city of Boston, 1 of whom shall be from the 13 South Boston section of the city of Boston, and 1 of whom shall be from the South End section 14 of the City of Boston; provided, however, that appointed members shall be versed in not less 15 than 1 of the following disciplines: airport operations; environmental affairs, labor relations;

- public health; or port operations. For purposes of this section, the term "chief executive officer"
- shall mean the person designated as the chief executive officer under a local charter or laws
- having the force of a charter, or, in the absence of a local charter or laws having the force of a
- local charter, the mayor, in a city, or the chair of the select board or president of a town council,
- in a town.
