In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to regional bonus aid.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 16D(g) of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 2 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the section in its entirety and inserting in
- 3 place thereof the following new section:
- 4 (g) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, regional bonus aid, but no other aid
- 5 pursuant to this section, shall be paid to any regional school district formed after fiscal year
- 6 nineteen hundred and ninety-three for the immediate five fiscal years following the establishment
- 7 of said regional school district. Regional bonus aid shall be payable in an amount equal to one
- 8 hundred dollars per foundation enrollment, in the first fiscal year following the establishment of
- 9 said regional school district; eighty dollars per foundation enrollment in the second fiscal year
- 10 following the establishment of said regional school district; sixty dollars per foundation

- 11 enrollment in the third fiscal year following the establishment of said regional school district;
- 12 forty dollars per foundation enrollment in the fourth fiscal year following the establishment of
- 13 said regional school district; and, twenty dollars per foundation enrollment in the fifth fiscal year
- 14 following the establishment of said regional school district.
