#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to school funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The secretary of administration and finance in cooperation with the
- 2 commissioner of revenue and the commissioner of education as appearing in Section 3A of
- 3 Chapter 70 of the General Laws shall include in said criteria, components, equations, and
- 4 underlying data necessary to generate the required minimum local contribution, a new
- 5 component.
- 6 Such new component shall, for municipalities with a population of 6,000 or less, exclude
- data regarding the highest five percent and lowest five percent of property values and resident
- 8 annual income of said municipalities, from calculations regarding local contribution.
