The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to rest homes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1. Section 72 of chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting the following:-
- 3 The department shall establish regulations for rest homes that are separate and distinct
- 4 from those regulations governing nursing homes. Such regulations should ensure requirements
- 5 that are consistent with current care practices and reflect the unique needs of the population that
- 6 reside in rest homes in contrast to those that reside in nursing homes. Such regulations for rest
- 7 homes shall allow for locks on the doors of resident rooms in order to ensure resident privacy.
- 8 Section 2. In developing proposed regulations for rest homes, the Department shall
- 9 consult with LeadingAge Massachusetts and the Massachusetts Association of Residential Care
- 10 Homes (MARCH).
