An Act relative to school safety and security.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 71 is hereby amended by inserting after section 97 the following section:-

2 Section 98. Each school shall conduct a live intruder training session within the first 90  
3 days of the academic year. The superintendent will work with the principal, teachers and school  
4 resource officer in each school to schedule and execute said training session. The superintendent,  
5 principal and school resource officer may alter each training session to reasonably accommodate  
6 the needs of each student. Notice will be provided to each student’s parent or guardian  
7 explaining the school’s intention to hold a live intruder training session within the specified time  
8 frame.
