In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to rest homes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 72 of chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting the following new sections:-
- 3 Section 1. The department shall establish regulations for rest homes that are separate and
- 4 distinct from those regulations governing nursing homes. Such regulations should ensure
- 5 requirements that are consistent with current care practices and reflect the unique needs of the
- 6 population that reside in rest homes in contrast to those that reside in nursing homes. Such
- 7 regulations for rest homes shall allow for locks on the doors of resident rooms in order to ensure
- 8 resident privacy.

- 9 Section 2. In developing proposed regulations for rest homes, the Department shall
- 10 consult with Leading Age Massachusetts and the Massachusetts Association of Residential Care
- 11 Homes (MARCH).
