An Act clarifying municipal authority regarding cash sureties.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 127I of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 Nothing in this chapter shall be read to preempt any municipal law requiring a cash
4 surety for a property identified as vacant or controlled by a foreclosing entity.

5 SECTION 2. Chapter 244, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after section
6 40 the following section:-

7 Section 41. Except where explicitly denied by the General Laws, municipalities shall
8 have authority to enact laws for the purpose of minimizing foreclosures, ensuring the safety and
9 security of residents, and ensuring the upkeep of vacant properties and those in foreclosure.
