*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 113B of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 2, the word "fifteenth" and inserting  
3 in place thereof the following word:- first.

4 SECTION 2. The thirteenth paragraph of said section 113B of said chapter 175, as so  
5 appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after the second sentence the following sentence:-  
6 There shall also be larger adjustments made for drivers with no surchargeable incidents within  
7 the 7 years immediately preceding the applicable rate year and within the 8 years immediately  
8 preceding the applicable rate year.
