Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 1760 of the General Laws is amended by adding the
2	following new sentence after the word "effectiveness" in the definition of "Adverse
3	determination":

4 Provided however, that in making said adverse determination, the carrier or its

5 designated utilization review organization shall defer to the judgment of the treating clinician

6 unless there is a preponderance of evidence that the requested admission, continued stay or other

7 health care service does not meet the requirements for coverage based on medical necessity,

8 appropriateness of health care setting and level of care, or effectiveness.
