An Act relative to the pesticide board.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3 of chapter 132B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by striking paragraph 5 and inserting in place thereof, the following
- 3 paragraph:-
- The board, in addition to other powers conferred in this chapter, shall advise the
- 5 commissioner of food and agriculture with respect to the implementation and administration of
- 6 this chapter. The commissioner of food and agriculture shall consult and concur with the
- 7 commissioner of environmental protection and commissioner of public health when rendering a
- 8 decision under section 13 of this chapter, relative to the protection of groundwater sources of
- 9 drinking water from pesticide contamination.
