In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

- 1 Ordered, that the Senate Committee on Rules shall develop an implementation plan to
- 2 withdraw from the existing joint committee structure and to establish separate Senate committees
- 3 to receive, hear and report on all legislative matters which may come before the Senate. The
- 4 Committee shall draw upon best practices from the forty-six states that employ separate branch
- 5 committees to develop a system that is transparent, responsive and efficient. In forming the
- 6 implementation plan, the Committee shall consider: the total number, titles, jurisdictions, and
- 7 members of the Senate committees; the need to replicate reporting and other deadlines; the
- 8 allocation of personnel, space and other resources; procedures for joint hearings by separate
- 9 branch committees; and any changes that may be needed to the Senate Rules or state statutes to
- 10 facilitate a smooth transition.
