The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Eleven
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An Act regarding adverse determinations for mental health and substance abuse treatment.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 176O of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “provider”, in line 20, the
3 following words: “provided, however, that in making an adverse determination for mental health
4 or substance abuse treatment, the carrier or its designated utilization review organization shall
5 defer to the judgment of the treating clinician unless there is a preponderance of evidence that the
6 requested admission, continued stay or other health care service does not meet the requirements
7 for coverage based on medical necessity, appropriateness of health care setting and level of care,
8 or effectiveness.”
